The Weather

The high yesterday 73° This morning's low 50°.

A Red Flag Warning is in Effect!

Today: Sunny with a high near 73°. Wind will become NW at 15-20 mph in the afternoon gusting to 30 mph.

Tonight: Look for mostly clear skies and down to about 42° overnight. Wind will become W near 5-15 mph overnight with possible gusts of 20 mph.

Friday: Sunny skies with a high temperature near 75°. Wind will be NW at 5-15 mph with gusts of 25 mph.

Friday Night: Clear and a low of 45°. Wind will become light and variable.

Saturday: Sunny and the high will be near 86°. Wind will become S at 10-15 mph with possible gusts as high as 25 mph.

Saturday Night: Mostly clear and a low near 60° with wind from the S at 15 mph gusting to 25 mph.

Red Flag Warning

Lampasas is under a Red Flag Warning today, as critical fire weather conditions are expected today roughly along and west of Interstate 35 where gusty northwest winds and very low humidity will coincide. In addition, a Wind Advisory is in effect for North Texas this afternoon with gusts as high as 45 mph possible.

Since January 1, 2022, Texas A&M Forest Service and local fire departments have responded to 3,018 wildfires that burned 403,711 acres. This total includes 978 wildfires in the month of March that burned 348,403 acres.

Wildfire activity is expected to gradually increase throughout the week, as periodic critical fire weather occurs where very dry vegetation is present across West and South Texas.

Texas A&M Forest Service continues to monitor the situation closely and has positioned personnel and equipment across the areas of concern for a quick and effective response to any new wildfire ignitions.



In addition to the more than 300 firefighters from Texas A&M Forest Service, more than 170 Texas Intrastate Fire Mutual Aid System (TIFMAS) firefighters as well as personnel from 28 states have been mobilized to assist with response efforts.

Thirty-three aircraft, including three large airtankers, 15 single engine air tankers, seven type 1 and type 3 helicopters, are also staged across the state for wildfire response

Finding Workers for Small Businesses

The president announced Friday that 431,000 jobs were added in March and unemployment numbers are just above a 50-year low. While that is good news for job seekers, many businesses are struggling to keep their doors open, not because of COVID-19 but because of a lack of staff.

Many business owners have no choice but to use temporary hours, many times having to step in themselves to go from boss to worker, like Manali Patel, who wears many hats throughout the day.

She helps make the salads at a Tossgreen location in Downtown Jacksonville. She also helps take calls and run the cash register.

But the actual title: "I'm the owner and president of the company," Patel said.

Patel owns three Tossgreen locations, and all of them have temporary hours.

"We are getting busier than before. Like we are now getting to where we want to be, but you don't have enough people to sell them," Patel said.

President Joe Biden touted his administration's jobs numbers Friday, saying the recovery has now created 7.9 million jobs.

"More jobs created over the first 14 months of any presidency in any term ever. And that is striking. But what's even more striking is this, in March, the unemployment rate fell to 3.6%, down from 6.4% when I took office 15 months ago, the fastest unemployment (drop) ever recorded," Biden said. But Patel said her small business is competing with all the others for the same worker.
