## The Weather

The forecasters say the cool front will come through Central Texas early on Tuesday. There is a very small chance of showers and storms when the front moves through. Temperatures behind the front should be more seasonal, at least for a few days.

**Today:** Sunny with a high near 93°. Wind will be S at 10-15 mph, gusting to 20 mph.

**Tonight:** Increasing clouds overnight with a low near 69°. The winds will be S-SE at 5-15 mph.

**Tuesday:** Mostly cloudy skies. With a high temperature near 80°. There is a 20% chance of showers and storms in the morning.

Winds will become N-NE at 5-15 mph in the morning.

**Tuesday Night:** Mostly cloudy with a low temperature near 59°. Winds will be N-NE at 5-15 mph possibly gusting to 20 mph.

**Wednesday:** Mostly sunny with a high near 81° and a light east wind

**Wednesday Night:** Partly cloudy skies with a low near 62°.

### Covid-19 Testing

The City of Copperas Cove will be hosting COVID-19 testing today at Fire Station #2 in Copperas Cove.

You must be experiencing some of the following symptoms to meet the criteria for testing: fever/chills, cough, fatigue, body aches/muscle/joint pain, shortness of breath, sore throat, headaches, nausea/vomiting/diarrhea, nasal congestion, loss of taste or smell.

Persons who meet the criteria **MUST** be screened, registered and receive an appointment in order to receive a test. Please visit TXCOVIDTEST.ORG or call 512.883.2400 to make an appointment.

The testing will be taking place from 8am to 5pm. Copperas Cove Fire Station #2 is located at 2401 FM 1113. Access to the testing site will be from the Grimes Crossing entrance.

This testing will be conducted by the Texas National Guard.

AdventHealth is also maintaining many of its social distancing policies by adjusting their current procedures. For example, patients coming to the hospital for treatment will check in remotely from their cars and remain outside until it is time for their appointments. Additionally, waiting rooms will be limited to a maximum of 5 people, and visitor restrictions will remain in place.
