Tonight: A 30% chance of rain before 10pm, then cloudy with a low around 72° and S-SE wind at 5-10 mph.


Tuesday: A 30% chance of rain again, up until 1pm, otherwise partly sunny with a high near 89° and the S-SE wind at 5-15 mph.

Lots of Golf at Hancock Park This Week and Weekend



Thursday:

One of Lampasas most famous, and interesting, golf tournaments plays out on Thursday at Hancock Park. It's the

34th Annual Curtis Bozarth Senior Classic.

The tournament tees off at 8am Thursday morning and should be finished about noon. The course will be closed for regular play during that time.

The Senior Classic features flites by age category. There's a 50-59 grouping, a 60-68, 69-76, and over 76 is the Super Senior Flite.

The tournament has been a favorite, since started by a former coach and scratch golfer Curtis Bozarth many years ago.

Friday:

A "Shoot Out" tournament will take place on Friday. It's a sort of pre-tourney for the Show Me The Money tournament described below. It will kick off with a shotgun start at 6pm Friday and features teams in an elimination contest until it gets down to winners. Cash Money prizes are available.

Saturday and Sunday:

Show Me The Money, the weekend tournament at Hancock Park, will kick off on Saturday, June 29th at 10am and finish up on Sunday with a 1pm tee time.

The course will be closed for regular play during those hours so if you want to play outside the tournament, you'll likely have to wait until the Saturday tournament finishes, or you can get it in Sunday morning early and plan to finish by noon-30.

Show Me The Money is a 2 person scramble/low ball tournament. On Saturday it's a Shamble where the team both hit drives, then take the best ball and play out each player's own ball from there, then record the best score. On Sunday, the two players simply play their own balls and record the best score for the hole. Cash money prizes, again, bring out the contestants.
