## LCRA Awards Grants to Adamsville and Kempner VFWs, Lampasas' 580 Sports Complex,

On June 26th, the Lower Colorado River Authority sent a press release which states that more than \$1 million in community project grants has been awarded to 44 cities throughout central Texas. Of those 44 were Kempner, Adamsville, and Lampasas.



#### Both Kempner and Adamsville received

grant funding for their Volunteer Fire Departments. Adamsville VFW received \$19,172 for new extrication tools, including inflatable airbags that can raise and stabilize vehicles, and heavy farm equipment. Kempner VFW received \$24,000 for hoses, nozzles, ladders and other essential equipment needed to equip a recently added second-hand engine. The city of Lampasas received \$25,000 for construction of the initial 4 miles of a hike and bike trail at the 580 Sports Complex.
