The Heat Index yesterday was 98°.

Today: Partly sunny with a high temperature near 93°, and a possible heat index of 98°. There is a 30% chance of precipitation this afternoon. Winds will be E at 5-10 mph.

Tonight: Look for mostly cloudy skies and a low near 73°, with the 30% chance of precipitation continuing. Winds will be N at 5-10 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph.

Anyone who has purchased fuel at the store recently should check their bank accounts and credit card statements.

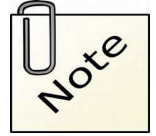
We want to recommend that citizens pay inside stores for fuel with your debit or credit card or use cash. These are your best options for not becoming a victim of this type of crime.

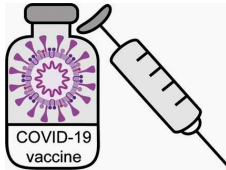
