Today: Look for mostly sunny skies and a high near 93° and a 30% chance of precipitation this afternoon. The heat index is forecast to reach 100°. Wind will be S today near 10 mph.

Tonight: Look for partly cloudy skies, and the low will get down to about 72° overnight with the 30% chance of showers continuing. The wind will be S near 10-15 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph.

Friday: Look for mostly sunny skies and a high temperature near 96° and a heat index near 100°. Wind will be S near 10 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph.

Friday Night: Mostly clear skies with a low near 74°. S wind near 10-15 mph with gusts as high as 20 mph.

Lampasas Volunteer Fire Department had a Busy Wednesday

The Lampasas Volunteer Fire Dept. (Lampasas VFD) had a busy Wednesday. At 11:19am the Volunteer Fire Dept. was called out to a location near CR 3064 for a structure fire. According to the Lampasas VFD, the structure was a new residential home, and the cause of a fire was a leaking gas line that ignited due to a spark. There were no injuries.

Later, at around 5:30pm, the fire department was called for mutual aid by the Burnet Fire Dept. to a grass fire between Lampasas and the Lake Victor cutoff. Multiple Burnet County fire agencies were on scene as well. While providing advanced warning for traffic control a Burnet County Sheriff's office SUV was struck by a passing by vehicle. The officer was not inside of the vehicle at the time. Minor injuries were reported to the driver of the other vehicle. The cause of the grass fire is undetermined and about 1 acre was burned.

State Sale Tax

State Sales Tax Revenue Totaled \$3.9 Billion in June

Texas Comptroller Glenn Hegar yesterday said state sales tax revenue totaled \$3.92 billion in June, 6.8% more than in June 2022. The majority of June sales tax revenue is based on sales made in May and remitted to the agency in June.

"The overall rate of sales tax revenue growth was in line with the rate of growth over the last three months," Hegar said. "Growth in receipts from sectors principally driven by business spending continued to outpace that from consumer-oriented retail trade.

Total sales tax revenue for the three months ending in June 2023 was up 5.9% compared with the same period a year ago. Sales tax is the largest source of state funding for the state budget, accounting for 56% of all tax collections.
