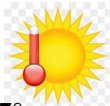

Lampasas County is under a Heat Advisory until 9pm tonight. Heat indices are expected to reach 105°-112°.

**Today:** Look for it to be sunny and hot with a high temperature topping out near 102° and a heat index of 109°. There is a slight chance of precipitation this afternoon. The SW wind will be near 5-10 mph.

**Tonight:** Tonight brings partly cloudy skies and a 20% chance of precipitation in the evening. The low temperature will be near 78°. The wind will be S-SW at 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

**Tuesday:** Partly sunny skies with a high temperature forecast near 102° and a heat index near 107°. The wind will be from the S near 10 mph.

**Tuesday Night:** Look for partly cloudy skies with a low temperature near 77°. The wind will be S near 10-15 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph.

## Commissioners Court

**The Lampasas County Commissioners Court** met today at 9am in the Commissioners Courtroom in the Lampasas County Courthouse.

The Agenda included the consent agenda to include quarterly and monthly reports. The Agenda also includes accounts payable and payroll, discussion about the Hill Country Transit District ( The HOP), awarding bids for aggregate for surface treatment, gas & diesel, temporary contracted service for Judge's Office and the TxDOT US 281N Lampasas to Evant open house on July 25<sup>th</sup>.

## Lampasas City Council

**The Lampasas City Council** will meet today for regularly scheduled meetings beginning with a workshop session.

The agenda for the workshop session includes discussion regarding the following: The Lampasas Central Appraisal District Budget (LCAD), the Hostess House revised scope w/Reliance Architecture, the July 17<sup>th</sup> Council Work Session Draft Agenda, a 2023-2024 budget update and the 2024 solar eclipse overall budget.

The regular session will begin immediately following the workshop session and may begin before 6pm.

The agenda for the regular session includes a Proclamation for 1<sup>st</sup> Responders Recognition for July 2023. The agenda also includes the City Manager's Operational report to include information on US 281N, a developer meeting, Hamilton EMS, Central Texas Water Supply Corporation, the Calvert Building and Conservation. In New Business, the agenda includes discussion and possible action on the following: regarding funding to rebuild the motor on teh 2004 F-350 Fire Dept. Brush Truck not to exceed \$22,000, to initiate a bid process for the revised scope for the Hostess House, and the LCAD budget. Items regarding the Solar Eclipse Event on April 8, 2024 are: accepting a proposal to lock in rates for sanitary restrooms in an amount not to exceed \$49,970 and locking in rates for Parking Management at the 580 Sports Complex in an amount not to exceed \$23,000.

The Council will then go into Executive Session relating to information about a business prospect that the city is in economic development negotiations and/or an offer of any financial or other incentives to any business prospect.

Council will then reconvene for action on executive session items.
