Fire Weather

Texas A & M Forestry service yesterday shared that as the triple digit temperatures returned this week, surface fuels have been drying. The heat combined with mostly sunny skies will increased fire ignition potential, especially during the afternoon hours.

The fire environment will support wildfire activity in Central Texas, as well as Southeast Texas, and Upper Gulf Coast. Dry surface fuel may continue to support moderate wildfire activity on Saturday and Sunday across these areas.

Speaking with Kempner Volunteer Fire Department Chief Connie Green this morning, Lampasas Radio confirmed that yesterday there were 3 minor flare-ups from the 190/Jackrabbit fire of the previous day. Chief Green stresses that if you don't have to burn then don't burn. If you have to, to please take precautions such as making sure the area around where you are going to burn is clear, wetting the area around where you will be burning, keeping a water hose nearby, and being aware that any spark can start a fire easily with the dry conditions. She also advises residents to be aware that farm or yard equipment or even trailers with chains can cause sparks. With high temperatures over 100° each day, low humidity, and winds gusting over 20 mph things can get out of hand quickly, and the grasses and fuel for fires are only going to be drying out more each day.

Llano County Moore Peak Fire

Emergency officials in Llano County are working to contain a brush fire that has burned around 500 acres of land near East State Highway 71 and Llano County Road 307 (Slab Road) that was sparked by an excavator. Texas A&M Forestry

shows that last night at 11:50pm, the fire was approximately 500



acres, 40% contained, and, according to updated information from kxan.com, 12 structures are threatened. There are over 20 agencies responding, including 13 volunteer fire departments and the Texas Forestry Service is providing air support.
