Lampasas ISD Free Meals

Lampasas ISD announced its policy that this school year, healthy meals will be offered every school day to all students at no cost. Typically, a student's household must meet income eligibility requirements to qualify for free or reduced price meals. However, the USDA issued guidance that allows schools to offer meals to all students at no cost for the 2021-2022 school year. Each school/site or central office has a copy of the policy, which may be reviewed upon request.

While no application or eligibility determination process is required for your student to receive free meals this school year, the income eligibility requirement will likely resume in the 2022-2023 school year.

Child Tax Credit Payments

According to a story yesterday on CBS news, the IRS will begin disbursing Child Tax Credit payments on Thursday, July 15. Here's what some 36 million American families need to know: The IRS will send the money on Thursday, but it will probably require two to three business days for the direct deposits to land in bank accounts, Mark Steber, Jackson Hewitt's chief tax information officer said. The reason for the delay is partly due to

the time required by banks to process and settle the funds, at which point the money can then be delivered to individual accounts. Likewise, the IRS will mail paper checks to people for whom it doesn't have bank account information. Those paper checks could take one to two weeks to arrive, Steber said.

As noted above, the expanded CTC provides a \$3,600 credit for each child under 6 years old and \$3,000 for each child age 6 to 17. The monthly payments represent half of the total credit, with the cash deposits running from July through December. For example, a family with one child under 6 will receive half of the \$3,600 credit in cash, or \$1,800, which will be split into six monthly checks of \$300 each. For children 6-17, the credit will be \$250 a month. The remainder of the CTC is claimed when you file your 2021 taxes next

The IRS says the monthly payments will be disbursed on these dates: July 15, August 13, September 15, October 15, November 15, December 15

"If you are a taxpayer and get your refund electronically deposited into your bank account, that's how you'll get the CTC," Steber said. However, if you want to make sure you are getting a direct deposit, you can check the IRS' Child Tax Credit Update Portal. The online tool will also allow you to update your bank account information. The CTC Update portal is also used to report children born in 2021, and opt out of the monthly payments, for example if you wanted to receive a larger refund at tax time. this is the link: https://www.irs.gov/ credits-deductions/child-tax-credit-update-portal
