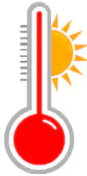

## The Weather

until tomorrow at 8pm.



**Today:** Look for sunny skies with a high near 106°. SW wind will be near 10-15 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph.

**Tonight:** Look for mostly clear skies with the low dropping to about 78° by morning. Wind will be S near 10-15 mph with possible gusts of 25 mph.

**Wednesday:** Sunny and hot with a high temperature near 106°. Look for wind to be S-SW near 10 mph.

**Wednesday Night:** Mostly clear skies with a low near 76° and S wind at 10-15 mph gusting to 25 mph.

**Thursday:** Sunny skies and the high will be near 103° with S wind near 10 mph.

**Thursday Night:** Mostly clear skies with a low near 76° and S-SE wind near 10-15 mph with possible gusts of 25 mph.

## From Kempner Water Supply

The Kempner Water Supply Corporation yesterday released the following to their customers:

“Please continue to conserve as much as possible at this time. Lawn irrigation is our biggest hurdle as it uses the majority of the unnecessary water. The grass may discolor but it can grow back or be replaced. Filling of ponds must stop and watering gardens that do not have vegetables should be done with a bucket, if at all. If lawn irrigation stops, we could conserve 30%-50% per month from that alone. All of these steps need to be taken to buy us more time while we wait for rain.”

*Conservation Tip: Gray Water (i.e. used dish or bath water) is a wonderful resource for watering plants and gardens.*

## The Blotter



**Lampasas Police Dept.** blotter for Monday shows an assault reported on Samac Lane at 10:32. The afternoon shows a minor accident in the 1000 block of fieldstone Dr. at 12:08pm and a criminal trespass reported in the 1300 block of E. Ave I at 3:12pm. Suspicious activity was reported in the 1400 block of 281S at 4:39pm and 5:52pm. At 6:37pm in the 2200 block of 190E, Joshua Earl, 23, of Lampasas was arrested for evading arrest w/vehicle and possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram. In the 2100 block of 190E at 7:32pm, Alexis Reyes, 26, of Ft. Worth was arrested for evading arrest. A disturbance was reported in the 100 block of EE Ohnmeiss Dr. at 7:36pm, there was a minor accident in the 700 block of Old Georgetown Rd. at 8:47pm and a domestic disturbance was reported in the 400 block of S. Western St. at 11:09pm.

**Lampasas Sheriff's Dept.** blotter Monday shows Lometa with an accident and civil matters. In Kempner there was a reported trespassing, a stolen vehicle report and reports of suspicious activity. Out in the county there were livestock/animal issues, civil matters reports of illegal dumping, an accident, a reported harassment, a requested welfare check and a warrant was served. Deputies went into Cove on a shots fired call, livestock issues and medical calls.

**The Jail Log** shows the arrest of 24 year old Sean Adams of Copperas Cove on a bench warrant. Daniel Spry, 49, of Kempner and Roland Vasquez, 37, of Lampasas were arrested for probation violations and Tyson Enterline, 42, of Kempner was booked in on a commitment charge.

*(cont'd from front)* Much of the state got enough rain earlier this year that reduced or eliminated drought conditions across the state and provided some cooling.

"We could conceivably crack the top three [warmest summers] but would have a hard time beating the summer averages from last year," said John Nielsen-Gammon, the state climatologist.

Locally, Lampasas has seen 19 day over 100°. In June there were 10 days over 100°, with 6 of those being consecutive from June 24-June 29. July has seen 9 days with triple digits so far, all consecutive from July 9-July 17, and no break in sight according to the national weather service. . The last measurable rain recorded at the airport was June 16th with .39 inches.

In El Paso, it's been more than a month since temperatures didn't reach 100 degrees — the longest stretch of 100° heat ever in that area. The previous record was set in 1994 with a 23-day long stretch of 100° heat, said Jason Grzywacz, a meteorologist for the National Weather Service in El Paso.

Since June 12, McAllen has recorded 30 days at or above 100 degrees, the second-longest such stretch since 1941, when recording began at that weather station. McAllen should soon break the all-time record of 31 triple-digit days, set in 1988.

## Lampasas ISD Gearing Up for New School Year

**Lampasas ISD District Wide** new student registration will take place this Wednesday, July 19<sup>th</sup> at Lampasas High School from 9am-6pm.

For the student, parents need to bring a certified birth certificate, a copy of the student's social security card, and current immunization records and, if applicable, a withdrawal form, transcript, final report card and/or other educational records from the last school the student attended.

Parents need to bring an approved photo ID (state issued driver's license, Texas State ID, a passport with current address or a military or government issued ID).

Parents also need to bring proof of residency. The approved documents include: A bill or a statement within the last 30 days that indicates the address in the parent/guardian's name. A lease or contract for the residential address in the parent/guardian's name is acceptable. We must have documentation of a binding agreement to reside at a residence within a specified timeframe. Additional documentation may be required to verify residency. A notarized signed/dated "Verification of Address From Property Owner" affidavit with whom the student lives, along with acceptable documentation of residency for homeowner/lessee.
