The Weather



High yesterday was 107° The low this morning was 76°

Lampas County is under an Excessive Heat Warning until 8pm tonight

As of today, Lampasas has seen 20 days of over 100° heat, 10 days in June and 10 consecutive days in July (9th-18th). The high temperature yesterday was 107° and tied for the hottest day of the year with June 20th.

Today: Sunny and hot with a high near 106°. Wind will be S-SW near 10-15 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph.

Tonight: Clear with a low around 75°. Wind will be S near 10-15 mph gusting to 25 mph.

Thursday: Sunny skies with a high near 104°. S wind will be near 10 mph.

Thursday Night: The temperature will drop to near 76° with mostly clear skies and a S-SE wind near 10-15 mph with gusts as high as 20 mph.

Friday: Mostly sunny with a high near 102° and S-SW wind near 5-10 mph.

Friday Night: Partly cloudy skies and a low near 77° with E-SE wind near 10-15 mph gusting as high as 20 mph.

Grass Fire near Adamsville

The Lampasas Volunteer Fire Department (LVFD), Kempner Volunteer Fire Department, Lometa Volunteer Fire Department, Adamsville Volunteer Fire Department, and the City of Lampasas Fire Department worked a grass fire yesterday on North US 281 started by a hay bailer.

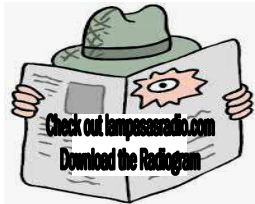

The Blotter



Lampasas Police Dept. blotter for Tuesday shows a report of suspicious activity in the 400 block of CTE at 9:06am and a suspicious person reported in the 300 block of Sunrise Hills at 9:47am. The afternoon shows a reported disturbance in the 1700 block of S. Key Ave. at 12:02pm. There were 2 minor accidents, one in the 700 block of S. Key at 12:02pm and one in the 2300 block of 281S at 7:23pm. A suspicious person was reported in the 1000 block of W. Ave E at 9:06pm and at 10:17pm, a 31 year old Lampasas woman was arrested on E. Ave D for driving with an invalid license and failure of financial responsibility.

Lampasas Sheriff's Dept. blotter for Tuesday shows Lometa with animal issues and a reported disturbance. In Kempner there were reported disturbances, medical calls, a report of a stolen vehicle, civil matters and an accident. Out in the county there were animal/livestock issues, civil matters, medical calls and a warrant was served. Deputies went into Cove on livestock issues.

The Jail Log shows the arrest of Natasha Smith, 39, of Kempner for misappropriation of fiduciary/financial property of elderly \$150,000-\$300,000. Also arrested was 43 year old Daniel Delacerda of Goldthwaite on a probation violation.

District Court Notes

Lampasas County Courthouse was the site of a 27th District Court Docket Call on July 14th. Presiding over the Court was 27th District Court Judge John Gauntt. Altogether 41 cases were brought to the court with 36 cases involving men and 5 cases involving women.

There were 18 cases involving possession of a controlled substance/PG1. There were 10 cases for possession less than a gram, with 1 of those being in a drug free zone. There were 3 cases for possession of 1-4 grams, and 5 cases for possession PG1 4-200 grams. There was 1 case of possession of a controlled substance PG2 4-400 grams. There were 2 DWI cases.

There were 4 cases for tampering with a government record, two cases for fraud and one case each for engaging in organized criminal activity, evading arrest, theft, forgery, criminal mischief, prohibited substance in a correctional facility and hindering a secured creditor.

In crimes involving personal harm, there was 1 case for accident involving injury and 3 cases for injury to a child/elderly/disabled person. There were 2 cases of aggravated sexual assault of a child and 1 case for indecency with a child/sexual contact.

Of the 41 cases 11 were resolved with Jesse Gonzales of Lampasas saw his charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram reduced to a misdemeanor and received 1 year in county jail. Anthony Rivera, on the charge of possession

of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram was sentenced to 15 months TDCJ with credit for time served. Abraham Rodriguez was sentenced to 5 years probation plus a \$500 fine and \$180 to DPS for each of two charges, possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram and engaging in organized criminal activity. Alvin Ray Pavey, on the charge of possession of a controlled substance was sentenced to time already served and court costs. Robert Baker on the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram was sentenced to 4 years probation plus court costs. On the charge of hindering a secured creditor, David Titus saw the charge dropped to a misdemeanor and was sentenced to 2 years probation, \$1000 restitution plus court costs., John Mezger was sentenced to 2 years TDCJ probated for 5 years with the stipulation of ISF plus court costs for one charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram and saw his other charge dismissed. David Clifton on the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram was sentenced to 18 months state jail with credit for time served. Monique Beaudry plead guilty and was sentenced to 10 years probation on the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 4-200 grams.

All other cases were reset or were set for jury trials.
