Lampasas County is under an excessive heat warning until 8pm tonight.

Today: Look for sunny skies and a high near 103°. Wind will be S-SW today near 5-10 mph.

Tonight: Clear skies and the low will get down to about 76° overnight. The wind will be S-SW near 10-15 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph.

Friday: Look for mostly sunny skies and a high temperature near 102°. Wind will be SW near 5-10 mph shifting E in the afternoon.

Friday Night: Mostly clear skies with a low near 77°.

E-SE wind near 10 mph shifting S overnight.

Saturday: Mostly sunny skies with the high temperature near 102°. The wind will be W near 5-10 mph shifting N-NE in the afternoon.

Saturday Night: Partly cloudy skies and the low will bottom out near 76° with a 20% chance of precipitation. Wind will be NE near 10 mph with possible gusts of 25 mph shifting SE overnight.

Triple Digit Days Continue

Yesterday Lampasas saw its 21^{st} triple digit day this year when the temperature reached 105° . July 19^{th} was the 11^{th} consecutive day of 100° heat and the forecast keeps us over 100° for the foreseeable future.

Water Issues...

could be on the horizon for area water customers. On July 7th, Kempner Water issued an alert that Stillhouse Hollow Lake, the only source of water for Kempner Water was at a critically low level and dropping 1 inch every 2 days. Kempner Water supplies water to the City of Lampasas.



As of this morning, Stillhouse Hollow Lake is at 606.80 feet elevation. If the water level reaches 606 feet elevation Kempner Water will implement stage IV water restrictions on their customers. When the water level reaches 605 feet elevation water production at the Kempner Water plant will slow down and at 604 feet elevation, water production will stop.
