The Weather

Lampasas County is under a Heat Advisory until 8pm tonight

Today: Look for sunny skies with a high temperature near 103°. Wind will be S-SW near 5-10 mph shifting E-NE this afternoon.

Tonight: Look for partly cloudy skies tonight and the low temperature will be near 77°. Wind will be E near 10 mph shifting W-SW overnight.

Saturday: Look for mostly sunny skies and a high temperature near 100°. NW wind will be around 5-10 mph shifting N-NE in the afternoon.

Saturday Night: Look for mostly clear skies with a low temperature near 77°. E wind will be near 5-10 mph.

Sunday: A high temperature near 103° with sunny skies and NE wind near 5-10 mph. There is a 20% chance of showers.

Sunday Night: Mostly clear skies with a low temperature near 77°. Wind will be E near 5-10 mph shifting S overnight. There is a 10% chance of precipitation.

City Fire Marshall Implements Burn Ban

The City of Lampasas Fire Marshal, JP Harris, has implemented a *citywide* burn ban effective for 90 days beginning yesterday and expiring on October 20th.

Outdoor burning within the City of Lampasas will no longer be allowed and the issuance of burn permits will cease.

Campfires and cooking fires are allowed. Fires of this nature should be constructed in a nonflammable container. A 55-gallon barrel with a metal screen over the top is acceptable. Residents are advised to wet the area around where the fire will be, *always* keep a hose nearby and if you don't have to burn, then don't.

Local fire departments advise residents to use extreme caution when conducting work related activities such as welding, metal grinding, and to be aware that lawn equipment or a chain on a trailer can spark a fire in these conditions.

When the fire danger is "Very High", (Lampasas is currently experiencing 'very high' fire conditions), fires will start easily and will spread rapidly with a quick increase in intensity. Small fires can quickly become larger fires. These fires are difficult to bring under control and will often become larger, longer-lasting fires.

Lampasas County at this time does *not* have a county-wide burn ban. County Commissioners have this on their agenda for their meeting on Monday July 24th.

In the meantime use extreme caution!

Extreme Heat Continues

Yesterday Lampasas saw its 22nd triple digit day this year when the temperature reached 103° yesterday. July 20th was the 12th consecutive day of 100° heat. We may see an end to the triple digit days this weekend as the high Saturday may not reach 100°.

If residents are having difficulty with utility bills, they can contact the Lampasas Senior Center at 512.556.2550 or stop by at 901 S. Live Oak and talk to the staff between 9am and 4pm.

As of this morning, Stillhouse Hollow Lake is at 606.74 feet elevation. If the water level reaches 606 feet elevation Kempner Water will implement stage IV water restrictions on their customers. Kempner Water states that when the water level reaches 605 feet elevation water production at the Kempner Water plant will slow down and at 604 feet elevation, water production will stop.

TxDOT Open House Next Week

TxDOT will be having local meetings concerning the construction on 281 between Lampasas and Evant.

TxDOT wants to widen US 281 between US 183 (Lampasas) and Live Oak Street (Evant) with two additional travel lanes for a total of four lanes, Improve safety by separating traffic with a grassy median, and add paved median crossovers along US 281 to facilitate access to and from both sides of the highway. However, a narrower roadway section may be considered at specific locations with significant existing constraints.



The purpose of the project is to improve mobility by constructing additional travel lanes and increase safety by bringing the roadway up to current design standards, separating northbound and southbound travel lanes with a grassy median and upgrading other safety treatments (guard rail, sloped culvert end treatments, wide shoulders, etc.). The project spans approximately 28 miles and will acquire additional right of way adjacent to the existing corridor (acreage to be determined pending final design); displacements may also be required but have not yet been identified.

The Lampasas meeting will be July 25th at New Covenant Church 1604 Central Texas Expressway from 5:30-7:30pm. The Evant meeting will be July 27th at the Evant ISD Cafeteria at 339 Memory Lane from 5:30-7:30pm
