Water Supply Reaches Maximum Contaminant Levels

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has

notified the City of Lampasas PWS ID TX1410001 that the drinking water being supplied to customers had exceeded the



Maximum Contaminant Level (MCL) for total trihalomethanes.

Trihalomethanes are **a group of volatile organic compounds** that are formed when chlorine, added to the water during the treatment process for disinfection, reacts with naturally-occurring organic matter in the water.

Some people who drink water containing trihalomethanes in excess of the MCL over many years **may experience problems** with their liver, kidney, or central nervous system, and may have an increased risk of getting cancer.

You do not need to use an alternate water supply. However, if you have health concerns, you may want to talk to your doctor to get more information about how this may affect you.





Finley deGraffenreid began the workshop session last night going over the budget priorities for the city as the 2025 budget is being

and wastewater departments are the recommended priorities for the city. Many projects and many sources of funding were also covered. The working budget for the city is \$34 million dollars and the budget runs at about \$33 million dollars.

Ryan Ward explained that the 2nd Street roadway improvement project from Main to Pecan is out for bidding, bid was later accepted by City Council for \$831,000. City Secretary Becky Sims discussed policies, regulations, and enforcement regarding short term rental regulations were also discussed. Letters are being prepared to send to homeowners of short term rentals to inform them of the Hotel Occupancy Tax payment requirements. The Wayfinding Sign Project bids were also discussed. Bids came in much higher than estimated costs. Council will review options.

Eddie Bowden from Coming Home Furniture presented about the impact of anticipated growth impact within the Texas Triangle. The potential for changing some zoning laws were also raised by Andy Fish so businesses can accommodate future growth opportunities to host larger events.

Zak Morris was approved for the golf course advisory board.

Discussion was had on proposals for Solid Waste Services. Three companies bid on the contract and the city will enter discussions with the highest ranked firm. Interlocal agreement was renewed between Lometa and Lampasas Fire Department for fire investigation services.

Western Avenue will be closed between 2nd & 3rd street on September 21 & 22 to accommodate the Western on Western Street fundraising event for the Lampasas County Museum. Health and vision insurance rates are increasing for city employees. Testing services for Hostess House renovation not included in original bid was also approved.

LCAD Lampasas Central Appraisal District 2024/25 budget was also approved by the City Council.
