
#### **County Commissioners' Court**

The City of Lampasas offers these suggestions that can have a big impact on water demand in our community and include: Avoid wasting running water as much as possible, Turn off the faucet while brushing your teeth, Only run the washing machine and dishwasher when you have a full load, use a water efficient flush toilet, take quick showers, use a low flow shower head and faucet aerators, find and repair leaks, don't over water your lawn or water during peak periods, and install rain sensors on irrigation systems. Water during the cooler parts of the day.
