## Social Media-Some of it all wrong, creates confusion.

The Kempner Water Supply Corporation (KWSC) experienced a main water line rupture Wednesday afternoon. The line feeds the Lampasas water system.

Although KWSC is busy getting the line repaired, Lampasas' faucets are still running because our system has a large storage tank that is supposed to contain roughly 24 hours of water. The city has implemented stage 5 water restrictions until everything is back and running. Afterward there will be boil water notices for everybody. Please understand that the City of Lampasas has not turned off the water system. It appears that even if the repairs were not made before the storage was depleted, we understand that the city may make arrangements to distribute water.

The situation this morning is that the KWSC has excavated the site of the break and is awaiting the arrival of the repair contractor, hopefully by noon today. In the meantime, please conserve water. Please note that the most reliable up-to-date information can be found at the city's website at lampasas.org.

The Lampasas Volunteer Fire Department shared with Lampasas Radio that the tanker trucks are all full in Kempner and Lampasas and will still operate at full capacity. They do recommend *NO OUTDOOR BURNING* including charcoal grills until all water is turned back on.

Please let your neighbors know how serious the situation is, and share information with anyone that may not have social media or access to the internet.



## From Texas A & M Forestry Service

On Wednesday, Texas A&M Forest Service responded to 13 new requests for assistance on wildfires that burned 815.4 acres across the state. The wildfire preparedness level is at a 3.

High pressure will continue to dominate Texas weather this week. Rain chances will be limited, and widespread triple digit temperatures return to the forecast. Over the past month, persistent hot and dry conditions have dried vegetation across the state.

Elevated fire weather combined with dry fuels will support wildfire activity through the weekend in Central Texas. Large wildfires that are resistant to suppression efforts may occur.

In our region, there are 2 fires that the Texas A & M Forestry service is assisting with.

The Cook fire is in far south San Saba County, is 75 acres and was 90% contained at 8:14am this morning. The Classic Canyon fire is in Coryell County, north of Gatesville and is 150 acres and was 20% contained at 9:45pm last night.

#### Tax-Free Weekend

Texas Comptroller Glenn Hegar is reminding shoppers they can save money on clothes and school supplies during the state's sales tax holiday on Friday, Saturday and Sunday, Aug. 11-13. State law exempts sales tax on qualified items — such as clothing, footwear, school supplies and backpacks — priced below \$100, saving shoppers about \$8 on every \$100 they spend. The Comptroller's office estimates that shoppers will save \$136 million in state and local sales tax during this sales tax holiday.
