The Weather

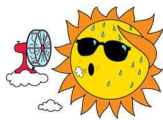
The High yesterday 100°
The Low this morning 75°

Today: Sunny and hot with a high near 100°. Winds will be S at 5-10 mph. The heat index will be in the 105°-110° range. The heat advisory has extended into Tuesday evening for areas near the 281 corridor. East of 281 an excessive heat watch remains in effect due to heat indexes reaching 110° or above.

Tonight: Mostly clear with a low in the upper 70's. Winds continue out of the south at 5-10 mph. **Tuesday:** More of the same, sunny and hot with a high near 102°. The Heat advisory continues through 7pm with readings forecast to be near 107° and S wind 5-10 mph. Tuesday night should be partly cloudy early then mostly cloudy with a 20% chance of storms after midnight, and lows in the upper 70's and S wind 5-10 mph.

Wednesday: A slight break as the forecast calls for partly sunny skies and a 30% chance of showers. If storms do develop, the outflow winds could be very strong. High temperatures will be in the upper 90's and possible heat index readings near 105°. NW winds are light around 5 mph and shifting to the NE in the afternoon.

Rest of the week: Highs in the mid 90's, with a 20% chance of showers on Thursday. Nights will be mostly clear with lows in the mid 70's.



The Lampasas City Council will meet for a workshop session Monday at 5:30pm to work on Departmental Budgets, an agreement with the DRT to use the Hostess House, funding sources for the Fiscal Year 2020 budget and discussion pertaining to the Chamber of Commerce 3rd quarter report.

A Public Hearing will be held in Council Chambers at 7pm Monday regarding the City Manager's Proposed Budget for Fiscal Year 2020



The Regular Session of Lampasas City Council will convene after the public hearing we are assuming. The regular session will include the introduction of Sgt. Steve Sheldon as a full time School Resource Officer, and the introduction of Jacob Hummer Patrol Sergeant. Officer Will Sneed will be presented with a Life Saving Award, and other city employees will be introduced.

The Agenda includes discussion and possible action regarding purchases and charges in excess of \$4,000 for the month of July. Routine matters will include the City Manager's Operational Report including back to school and an update on the goats. In new business the Chamber will be considering the approval of HOT funds for the Wine Tour and a resolution for the city to acquire a .04 acre tract of land situated in block 60, Lampasas Springs Addition for use as an easement for public drainage utilities and/or other municipal purposes. This will authorize the City Attorney to file Eminent Domain if necessary.

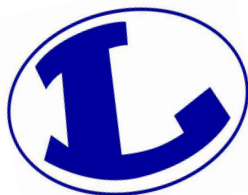
