## The Weather

The High yesterday 95° The Low this morning 78°

The heat index reached 98° in Lampasas yesterday.

Lampasas County is under a heat advisory from 1pm today to 7pm tomorrow. Use Caution if you have to be outside.

The forecasters say there is a slight chance for precipitation this afternoon and early evening. Areas east of I-35 could see heat indexes of 111° this afternoon. The heat advisory for areas west of 281 is based on actual temperatures, not heat index. Highs are expected to be 104°-107°. The 100° weather will continue through the beginning of next week, but near normal temperatures and rain chances return on Tuesday or Wednesday.

**Today:** Hot and mostly sunny with a high near 101°, and a heat index near 104°. Winds will be S-SW at 5-15 gusting to 20 mph. There is a 20% chance of storms this afternoon.

**Tonight:** Mostly clear skies and a low near 77°. Winds will be S -SE winds at 5-15 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph.

**Saturday:** Sunny and HOT with a high temperature near 103°, and heat indices of 106°. Winds will be S-SW near 5-10 mph., shifting SE in the afternoon.

**Saturday night**: Look for mostly clear skies with a low near 76°. Winds will be S at 5-10 mph.

**Sunday**: Sunny and hot with a high near 101°. S-SW winds at 5-10 mph.

**Sunday Night**; Mostly clear and 77°. Winds will be S- SE near 10 mph gusting to 20 mph.

#### **Trooper Talk**

This morning in Lampasas Radio Studios,

Sgt. Bryan Washko, head of Safety Education for this area. was on the air with Ken Gontarek.

They discussed a myriad of subjects, beginning with Hurricane Laura and how Texas dodged a bullet, with less damage than expected.

They discussed the ongoing problem of sex trafficking, and the incident in Cisco where a woman who had been kidnapped in El Paso jumped from an 18-wheeler on I-20 near a truck stop. She also reported that there was another woman in the truck and the men had indicated they would use the women for sex trafficking. There is a statewide alert for the tractor-trailer, a green truck tractor with a white stripe and pulling a white box type trailer. The truck is occupied by two Cuban males and a Caucasian male. If you see what may be this vehicle, call 911 or the Cisco Police Dept. at 254-629-1728. Stay alert, Sgt. Washko said, because 281 is a thoroughfare from Mexico.

Be aware of your surroundings, and he said 'If it doesn't look right, it probably isn't.

Sgt. Washko asked that we pay attention to amber alerts.

Texas has 22,000,000 registered vehicles, and there are 9 or 10 fatalities a day in traffic accidents. The major factor is distracted driving. Studies show that you are 20 times more likely to have an accident if you are texting, than if you are driving drunk.

(DWI's are way down, due to the pandemic.

The other issue is people still don't use their seat belts, and child safety seats.

And he asked that we keep an eye out for school buses.


