Shooting in Lampasas

Lt. Chuck Montgomery of the Lampasas Police Department released the following yesterday at 4:45pm:

On August 31st, 2023, at approximately 10:41am a 911 call was received by Lampasas Police Department Communications reporting that a woman had been shot by her husband at 2 Cameron Dr. in the City of Lampasas. Lampasas Police Department, Lampasas County Sheriff's Department, Lampasas Fire Department, and Hamilton County EMS responded to the call.

First officers arrived on scene at approximately 10:43 am, and were directed to a 69-year-old female who was seated in the yard of a residence close to the alleged scene of the shooting. The victim alleged that she had been shot 4 times by her husband who was believed to still be at the residence where the shooting had occurred. Information indicated to officers at the scene that the shooter was in the residence alone. Officers set up a perimeter of

victim was evacuated from the scene and transported by Hamilton County EMS. The victim is alive and in the care of a hospital, but the extent and seriousness of her injuries are unknown to us at

the scene, and handled the scene as a barricaded subject. The

unknown to us at this time.

Lampasas Police Department requested the assistance of the Texas Department of Public Safety.



Resources with Texas DPS Swat Team, Hostage Negotiation Team, Highway Patrol, and Texas Rangers did respond and assist Lampasas Police Department with this incident.

After attempts to establish communication with the suspect were unsuccessful, DPS Swat entered the residence. Inside they found a 76-year-old male deceased. Evidence at the scene leads us to believe that the suspect died by self-inflicted gunshot wound.

This case is in currently under investigation, and the names of the suspect and victim are being withheld pending notification of their family. Further information will be released when it becomes available."


