State Revenue for Fiscal 2023

Texas Comptroller Glenn Hegar yesterday released totals for fiscal 2023 state revenues, in addition to announcing monthly state revenues for August.

General Revenue-related revenue for fiscal 2023 totaled \$82.84 billion, up 8.3 percent from fiscal 2022. Sales tax revenue was \$46.58 billion, up 8.4 percent from fiscal 2022.

The Economic Stabilization Fund and State Highway Fund both receive funding from oil and natural gas severance taxes. In November, the Comptroller's office will deposit \$3.06 billion in each of those funds in fiscal 2024, down from the \$3.64 billion deposited in each fund in fiscal 2023.

Hegar also said state sales tax revenue totaled \$3.98 billion in August, 5.7 percent more than in August 2022.

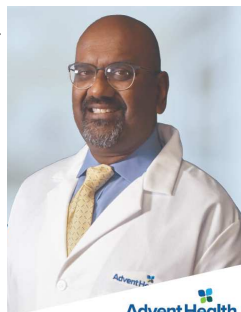

Fire Safety during Hunting Season



During the upcoming dove hunting season, Texans are urged to help protect the lands and natural resources that we all love by being mindful of activities that may cause a wildfire.

"Since mid-June, Texas has been marked by devastating wildfires that have burned more than 75,000 acres," said Wes Moorehead, Texas A&M Forest Service Fire Chief.
