Burn Ban in Effect! No Outdoor Burning!

From DPS: At 1:50am Wednesday, Texas DPS Troopers responded to a major crash involving a truck tractor semi-trailer at the intersection of 281 & Highway 6. The semi was traveling southbound on 281 entering the City of Hico. As the truck approached the intersection of State Highway 6 and US 281 the truck was traveling at an unsafe speed and failed to maintain a single lane. The semi-truck lost control and collided with a traffic light pole and ran into the parking lot of the Yesway gas station. The truck then rolled onto its right side and exploded. The fire engulfed the

semi-trailer. The 22-year-old male driver from Utah escaped injury. The 33-year-old male passenger was transported to Stephenville ER for nonincapacitating



injury. The intersection was closed for several hours and reopened approximately 7:00 a.m.

The Hamilton County Scanner Facebook Page added this: "We would be remiss if we did not say, it has been reported that a Hico resident was out walking his dog when the crash happened. 
ERCOT Moved into Emergency Operations Last Night

ERCOT, the state's power grid operator triggered its emergency operations on Wednesday evening, allowing it to call on all available power generation to stay ahead of demand. The level 2 emergency was in place for a little over an hour. If ERCOT had called for electricity cuts on Wednesday, the location and duration of power outages would have been controlled by individual electric utilities.

Today's demand forecast at 8pm according to the ERCOT website is 80,423 MWs and the forecast capacity at that time is 80,456 MWs.
