Fire in Northern Lampasas County

A wildfire broke out yesterday afternoon near County Road 3831 and Hwy 281 in northern Lampasas County. According to the Lampasas County Sheriff's Department (LCSO), 281 was closed for a period of time due to the smoke at the request of the Texas Forestry Service.

The fire, called the 'Big John' fire, was estimated at 150 acres and 15-20% contained this morning according to Adamsville VFD Chief Watson.

He shared with Lampasas Radio that a few structures were in danger but due to the quick response no one had to be evacuated. Adamsville VFD Chief Watson asks that the public stay away, as the fire is still active and more Forestry Service

Sales Tax Rebates

Texas Comptroller Glenn Hegar announced yesterday he will send cities, counties, transit systems and special purpose taxing districts 1.1 Billion dollars in local sales tax allocations for September. That is up 3.4% from last year. These allocations are based on sales made in July by businesses.

In our area, Evant in Hamilton County saw their rebate drop by 20.64% over the same period last year, with a \$6583.32 rebate. The City of Hamilton saw a .99% decrease over the same month last year in their rebate check of \$66,080.50

In Lampasas County, Lampasas shows their rebate is down with a 9.13% decrease in their check of \$227,121.42. Lometa shows a whopping increase of 42.79% from last year with a rebate check for \$9,138.60 and Kempner received a rebate for \$14,095.48, a 28.19% increase from last year.
