Today: Skies will be mostly sunny with a high temperature near 106° and a 30% chance of showers this afternoon. Wind will be from the SW near 5-10 mph shifting N-NW in the afternoon.

Tonight: Look for mostly cloudy skies with a low near 73° and the 30% chance of showers continuing. Wind will be from the W-NW near 5-10 mph becoming E overnight.

Sunday: The high temperature will climb to near 98° with mostly sunny skies and a 30% chance of showers and storms in the afternoon. Wind will be E near 5-10 mph.

Sunday Night: Overnight it gets down to 72° with partly clear skies and the 30% chance of showers continuing. Wind will be SE near 5-10 mph.



Lampasas City Council

The Lampasas City Council will meet Monday for regularly scheduled meetings beginning with a workshop session at 5:30pm.

The agenda for the workshop session includes discussion regarding the following: updates on the hike/bike trail and disc golf and the mentorship program between Lampasas Animal Shelter and Williamson County Regional Animal Shelter and funding through Best Friends Animal Society.

The regular session will begin immediately following the workshop session. The agenda includes public hearings on the following: a request for a specific use permit to allow the sale of portable buildings at 615 CTE in Lampasas, a request for a specific use permit to allow a daycare at 808 S. Western Ave. in Lampasas, amending the zoning regulations to consider Single Family Residential-10 zoning classifications in the Hillside Acres Subdivision and the Hidden Oaks Subdivision, re-zoning the recently annexed property in the Hereford Lane, Supple Drive, Mockingbird Lane area to Multi Family apartments and amending the ordinance to allow for a 4-way stop sign at 4th & Spring.

The agenda also include the City Manager's Report to include discussion of the airport, water conservation, Hancock Pool, a Developer's Meeting and, of course, the 2024 eclipse.

New Business will include discussion and possible action regarding awarding a bid to Ryan Bales, Badger Buildings & Storage to build a cattery at the Lampasas Animal Shelter in an amount not to exceed \$28,699.00. There will also be discussion and possible action regarding approving the 2024 FY Budget and the 2024 FY tax rate and ratifying the property tax revenue increase reflected in the new budget. There will be discussion on approving or denying the items discussed in the public hearings.
