District Court Notes

Lampasas County Courthouse was the site of a 27th District Court Docket Call on September 15th. Presiding over the Court was 27th District Court Judge John Gauntt. Altogether 42 cases were brought to the court with 32 cases involving men and 10 cases involving women.

There were 17 cases involving possession of a controlled substance/PG1. There were 7 cases for possession less than a gram with 1 being in a drug free zone. There were 6 cases for possession of a controlled substance PG1 1-4 grams and 3 cases for possession of a controlled substance PG1 4-200 grams. There was one case for manufacture/delivery of a controlled substance PG1 4-200 grams. There was one case for possession of a controlled substance PG2 4-400 grams. There were 3 DWI cases. There were 4 cases for fraud, two cases each for burglary and evading arrest with a vehicle, and 1 case each for harassment of a public servant, engaging in organized criminal activity, enhanced forgery and criminal mischief w/ intent to interrupt a public service.

In crimes involving personal harm, there were 2 cases for injury to a child/disabled/elderly person, and 1 case each for abandoning/jeopardizing a child, deadly conduct (discharge of a firearm), violating a protective order assault/stalking, assault on a family member and aggravated assault w/deadly weapon.

There was 1 case each of sexual assault and sexual assault of a child.

Of the 41 cases 5 were resolved with Payphiel Porter sentenced to 7 years probation plus a fine and court costs on the charge of engaging in organized criminal activity. Ronnie Knepler of Kempner saw his charge of criminal mischief with intent to impair/interrupt public service dismissed. On the charge of abandoning/jeopardizing a child Brittany Fox saw her motion to adjudicate probation withdrawn as did Branden Tengler of Kempner on the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 1-4 grams with the condition of attending a SAFFP program.

All other cases were reset or were set for jury trials.

El Niño



According to a story at kxan.com, it's been a given for several months that we would be looking at an El Niño in the winter. The latest guidance released within the last week now suggests 99% certainty of El Niño from December through February. It won't just be a regular El Niño either, there are 60% odds it will be a "strong" El Niño. The stronger the El Niño, the more likely its effects will occur, not that those effects would be "worse."

Typically we see the most predictable impacts from El Niño in Central Texas during the winter. Usually this means wetter and cooler weather.

The mid-August release of the winter forecast from the Climate Prediction Center (CPC) has odds in our favor for more rain this winter, but the temperature outlook is near normal.

Winter is usually our driest season with only 7.25" in an average meteorological winter in Austin from December through February. Catching up on precipitation deficits that have grown through the year would do wonders for us heading into the warmer months next year.

You can expect fewer severe weather instances of tornadoes and especially hail next spring if El Niño continues as expected. This doesn't mean no hail or tornadoes, just fewer occurrences.

As for next summer...so much of that will depend on how wet we are in the winter and spring. The wetter those seasons are, the wetter the soil is, which generally means it's harder to warm up as excessively. It would still be hot and more humid, but not as many triple digits. Only time will tell.
