Speed Limit During Construction

Lampasas Radio reached out to TxDOT in Brownwood this morning about the speed limit on that stretch of highway. TxDOT approached the Lampasas City Council and on June 12th the Lampasas City Council unanimously approved lowering the speed limit during construction in this area at the request of TxDOT.

Jason Scantling explained that TxDOT is still going through the process to lower the speed limit on 281S from the Burnet County line into Lampasas during the construction of that stretch of roadway. It has to go before the Texas Transportation Commission and they hope to do that in October and start putting up new speed limit signs beginning November 1st.

While this speed limit will only be effective during construction, Mr. Scantling said TxDOT will re-evaluate the speed limit by the high school when the construction is complete. Since this is a state highway that travels through a municipality (The City of Lampasas) changing the speed limit has to be a collaborative effort.

Upcoming Special Legislative Session

A story in the Texas Tribune tells us that Gov. Greg Abbott said Tuesday his long-awaited special session on "school choice" will start next month while promising political consequences for law-makers who stand in the way of his priority legislation.

The idea has long encountered resistance in the House, where a coalition of Democrats and rural Republicans have blocked it. When the regular session ended, Abbott vowed to call multiple special sessions on unfinished business, including school choice.

Divisions between the House and Senate have only deepened since then, with back-to-back special sessions on a property tax stalemate and then the impeachment trial of Attorney General Ken Paxton.
