The Lampasas Airport received 1.32 inches of rain yesterday

Today: Cloudy skies with a high near 55° and a 70% chance of precipitation and thunderstorms likely later this afternoon. Wind will be N-NE near 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Tonight: Look for cloudy skies. a low near 47° and a 100% chance of precipitation. Wind will be NE at 5-10 mph gusting to 20 mph, shifting W-NW overnight. Patchy fog is possible

Saturday: Look for cloudy skies and a 40% chance of rain, then gradual clearing. The high temperature will be near 56°. Wind will be W near 5-15 mph gusting to 30 mph.

Saturday Night: Look for clear skies with a low temperature near 42°. The wind will be W-SW near 5-10 mph with possible gusts of 25 mph.


Today is Black Friday



Texas DPS Troopers responded to a report of a multi-car fatality crash in the northbound lanes of IH-35 near Troy at 6:24pm on November 23rd. Investigating Troopers stated that multiple cars were stopped due to heavy holiday rush traffic. A 2017 Nissan Titan pickup truck failed to control speed and collided with multiple vehicles. As a result of the collision a 13-year-old male and an 8-year-old male both from Uvalde, Texas, had died on scene and were pronounced deceased by Justice of the Peace Duffield. Next of kin have been notified. More information to follow, the crash investigation is still active and open.
