The Weather



The High yesterday was 65° The Low this morning 46°
Today: A cloudy day with a slight chance of rain. The high should be about 61° this afternoon so most of our day will be in the 50s. The calm wind of morning will turn to 5-10 mph out of the south.

Tonight: Showers seem likely overnight (60% chance) and lots of cloud and after midnight it could get foggy. The low overnight should be about 54° and the S-SE wind will likely be very light or calm.

Tuesday: Showers and thunderstorms seem to be very likely. As a matter of fact the forecast says a 100% chance of some kind of welcome rain. The high should be around 62° as the calm wind becomes a very light west wind. Overnight it could drop down to about 47°.

The rest of the Week: Wednesday is expected to bring a warm front as the wind shifts to southerly and the afternoon high reaches to about 70°. Thursday will bring 70-ish temps all day with a brisk S-SW wind gusting to 20 mph. It appears that rain chances come back in on Thursday night or Friday as a cold front arrives Friday. That will likely bring cold Friday night and chilly weather for the weekend.
